South Eastern, Australia 2006

12 Marques de Caceres Rioja Blanco

Rioja, Spain 2007

13 Yalumba Y Series Viognier

South, Australia 2007

£21.00

The rare and aromatic Viognier grape is being transplanted into the Southern Hemisphere with increasing success. This is a full-bodied dry white from Yalumba with a gorgeously perfumed scent and a ripe, peachy fruitiness.

- 14 Southbank Estate Sauvignon Blanc
Marlborough, New Zealand 2007 £22.50
Displaying ripe gooseberries followed by crisp, clean acidity and a refreshing finish that are the hallmark of this unmistakable Marlborough Sauvignon.
- 15 Chablis, Cave de Chablis
Burgundy, France 2006 £23.00
A steely, minerally and flinty Chablis, that is elegant and refined.
- 16 Bonterra Vineyards Chardonnay (Organic)
Mendocino County, California 2005/06 £24.50
Bonterra's belief that the use of organically grown grapes make wines "simply taste better" has fuelled their quest in becoming one of the world leaders in organic viticulture. A well-balanced Chardonnay with subtle nuances of vanilla oak, crisp acidity and a full rich flavour.
- 17 Gavi di Gavi Raccolto Tardivo, Villa Lanata
Italy 2006/07 £25.50
Made from the Italian Cortese grape, this ripe, crisp fulsome white is harvested late in the season to give even more grapefruit & apricot intensity, with refined strength.
- 18 Cape Mentelle Semillon Sauvignon
Margaret River, Australia 2006 £32.00
This blend is becoming increasingly popular - the herby green fruit evident from the Sauvignon is perfectly complemented by the flowery Semillon. Absolutely mouthwatering - a fabulous wine.
- 19 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc
Marlborough, New Zealand 2007 £37.50
A bright blast of grassy fruit on the nose, with a powerful lemon cream character. On the palate it is big, quite minerally, with sweetly ripe and yet fresh and green fruit.
- 20 Chablis Grand Cru, Vocoret
Burgundy, France 2006 £45.00
The Grand Cru Blanchots vineyard produces wines that are amongst the most delicate, perfumed and stylish of all the Chablis Grand Crus. This medium-bodied example offers zesty, clean lemon fruit on the palate with rich undertones yet crisp acidity.

- 21 Robertson Winery Cabernet Sauvignon
South Africa 2006/07 £14.95
A beautifully smooth full bodied red enhanced by rich mulberry, plum and cassis fruits and subtle soft tannins.
- 22 Coldridge Estate Shiraz Cabernet
South Eastern , Australia 2006 £15.95
A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours. Spicy Shiraz, lightened by leafy Cabernet Sauvignon, and enriched by a touch of oak.
- 23 Neblina Merlot
Central Valley, Chile 2007 £15.95
On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours.
- 24 Vistasur Cabernet Sauvignon
Central Valley, Chile 2007 £16.50
A fruit driven Chilean Cabernet full of blackcurrant fruit, vanilla spice, soft structure and a wonderfully rounded finish.
- 25 Rioja, Bodegas de Abalos
Rioja, Spain 2006/07 £17.00
From the leading wine region in Spain, this Rioja is violet in colour and soft and fruity in style. Warm, plummy aromas tinged with subtle spice and vanilla.
- 26 Adobe Merlot (Organic)
Central Valley, Chile 2007 £18.50
Deep cherry-red in colour, it shows intense strawberry and raspberry aromas, subtly lifted by notes of chocolate and cream. Organic!
- 27 Chianti Loggia Del Conte, Le Chiantigiane
Italy 2006 £18.50
Made from the Sangiovese and Canaiolo grapes, this wine has delightful aromas of cherries and violets and youthful red fruit flavours on the palate.
- 28 Beyerskloof Pinotage
Stellenbosch, South Africa 2006 £18.50
This Pinotage has all the ripeness of the Cape's best wines, and with a lovely long smokey finish.
- 29 Yering Frog Pinot Noir
Yarra Valley, Australia 2007 £19.50
Partial fermentation in aged French oak gives this wine savoury undertones which balance perfectly with the ripe raspberry and black cherry flavours.

- 30 Wyndham Bin 555 Shiraz
South Eastern, Australia 2004/05 £19.95
Packed with delicious jammy blackberry fruits, peppery spices and perfectly rounded with oaky vanilla flavours.
- 31 Antony's Yard, Graham Beck
Western Cape, South Africa 2005 £21.50
Bordeaux style, produced from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Red and black fruits on the nose and palate, with hints of cigar box.
- 32 Fleurie Flower Label, Georges Duboeuf
Beaujolais, France 2006/07 £22.50
The epitome of a Beaujolais Cru. Fruity, scented with an attractive silky texture and fresh raspberry fruit from Mr Beaujolais himself.
- 33 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rémy Ferbras
Rhône Valley, France 2006 £27.50
A classic Chateauneuf delivering full bodied bramble fruit flavours and well balanced herbaceous character.
- 34 Rioja Berberana Gran Reserva
Rioja, Spain 2000 £29.50
A stunning Gran Reserva. Complex layers of mellow toasted oak and baked fruit flavours and a sumptuous lingering finish.

Bordeaux, France 2004 £31.00
Fantastic. Mainly from merlot creating a complex fruity body with winter red berries and subtle cherry vanilla notes.

Italy 2004 £37.00
A deliciously mature Barolo offering raisin and plum fruit aromas. Well-structured with good acidity and length.
- 37 Chateau Tayac, Margaux
Bordeaux, France 2000 £35.00
With a complex nose of blackberry, cigar box and violets the palate is ripe and silky with terrific intergration of fruit, structure and structure and wood and a long length.

Australia £50.00
