13 Soave Classico, Veneti, Negrar

Veneto, Italy, 2009

A delicious example of this underrated high quality region. Notes of green olive and lemon zest crisp and elegant, a fresh and sprightly wine.

14 Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, New Zealand, 2009

£19.95

Displaying ripe gooseberries followed by crisp, clean acidity and a refreshing finish that are the hallmark of this unmistakable Marlborough Sauvignon.

15 Chablis, Jean Bourguignon

France, 2009

£24 00

A lively & fresh Chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character. The finish is long & lean, perfect for accompanying meaty white fish.

- 16 Bonterra Vineyards Chardonnay (Organic)**
California, 2008 **£25.50**
Bonterra's belief the use of organically grown grapes make wines "simply taste better" has fuelled their quest in becoming one of the world leaders in organic viticulture. A well-balanced Chardonnay with subtle nuances of vanilla oak, crisp acidity & a full rich flavour.
- 17 Gavi di Gavi La Toledana, Villa Lanata**
Italy, 2009 **£26.50**
Made from the Italian Cortese grape, this ripe, crisp fulsome white is harvested late in the season to give even more grapefruit & apricot intensity, with refined strength.
- 18 Cape Mentelle Semillon Sauvignon**
Margaret River, Australia, 2008/09 **£33.00**
This blend is becoming increasingly popular - the herby green fruit evident from the Sauvignon is perfectly complemented by the flowery Semillon. Absolutely mouthwatering - a fabulous wine.
- 19 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc**
Marlborough, New Zealand, 2009 **£38.50**
A bright blast of grassy fruit on the nose, with a powerful lemon cream character. On the palate it is big, quite minerally, with sweetly ripe and yet fresh and green fruit.
- 20 Chablis Grand Cru, Vocoret**
Burgundy, France, 2009 **£46.00**
The Grand Cru Blanchots vineyard produces wines that are amongst the most delicate, perfumed and stylish of all the Chablis Grand Crus. This medium-bodied example offers zesty, clean lemon fruit on the palate with rich undertones yet crisp acidity.

Australia, 2008

A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours. Spicy Shiraz, lightened by leafy Cabernet Sauvignon, and enriched by a touch of oak.

22 Esperanza Merlot

Argentina, 2009

A smooth, soft merlot, with ripe aromas of raspberries, plums and cherries.

23 Aires Andinos Malbec

Argentina, 2009

A rich, ripe wine with plenty of smooth black fruit and warming hints of spice.

24 Vistasur Cabernet Sauvignon

Chile, 2008

£16.95

A fruit driven Chilean Cabernet full of blackcurrant fruit, vanilla spice, soft structure and a wonderfully rounded finish.

25 Rioja, Bodegas de Abalos

Spain, 2007/08

£17.00

From the leading wine region in Spain, this Rioja is violet in colour and soft and fruity in style. Warm, plummy aromas tinged with subtle spice and vanilla.

26 Baron de Baussac, Carignan Vieilles Vignes

France, 2009

£17.50

Bordeaux style, produced from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Red and black fruits on the nose and palate, with hints of cigar box.

27 Chianti Loggia Del Conte, Le Chiantigiane

Italy, 2008

£18.50

Made from the Sangiovese and Canaiolo grapes, this wine has delightful aromas of cherries and violets and youthful red fruit flavours on the palate.

28 Bantry Bay Pinotage

South Africa, 2009

£18.50

Soft and rounded with notes of bramble fruit on the palate.

29 Otterbrook Mill Shiraz

Australia, 2008

£19.50

Packed with delicious jammy blackberry fruits, peppery spices and perfectly rounded with oaky vanilla flavours.

- 30 Fairleigh Estate Pinot Noir**
Marlborough, New Zealand, 2008 **£25.00**
Hand harvested from vines on the southern side of the Wairau Valley, this is a classic Pinot from respected winemaker Brent Marris. Delicious berry fruit and subtle spicy aromas with well balanced tannins.
- 31 Bonterra Vineyards Zinfandel (Organic)**
California, USA, 2006 **£25.00**
This formidable Zinfandel was 100% barrel fermented, resulting in a rich black cherry-scented wine with a lovely spicy finish.
- 32 Rioja Reserva, Vina Pomal**
Rioja, Spain, 2005 **£28.50**
This is everything you'd want from a Rioja Reserva and much more. Bursting with red fruit characters of blackberry and raspberries the palate is clean, intense and persistent. Perfectly balanced with soft velvety tannins it is delicious from start to its very long finish.
- 33 Fleurie Flower Label, Georges Duboeuf**
Beaujolais, France, 2009 **£30.50**
The epitome of a Beaujolais Cru. Fruity, scented with an attractive silky texture and fresh raspberry fruit from Mr Beaujolais himself.
- 34 Château Greysac, Médoc, Cru Bourgeois**
Medoc, France, 2006 **£31.00**
An excellent value Cru Bourgeois wine, offering plenty of classic Médoc flavours of cassis, black cherry and plum fruits, balanced by hints of vanilla and spice.
- 35 Chateau Orme Brun, Grand Cru**
France, 2007 **£32.00**
Brimming with enticing fruit cake and plum flavours this wine has a long-lasing finish.
- 36 Barolo "Galarej" Fontanafredda**
Piemonte, Italy, 2004/05 **£35.00**
This is a robust, full bodied wine packed with structure. The bouquet is clean, full and intense, with typical Barolo characteristics of wild roses and tar.
- 37 Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Cuvée des Antiques'**
Rhone, France, 2007 **£35.00**
Aged in the famous cellars of Ogier Caves des Papes in the heart of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear with a smooth and lingering finish.
- 38 Wakefield, St. Andrews Cabernet**
Australia, 2004 **£50.00**
With lively, black cherry, liquorice & cassis fruit characters, balanced by subtle cinnamon, spice & cedar notes. With a strong palate & fine, long tannins & clean, crisp finish.
